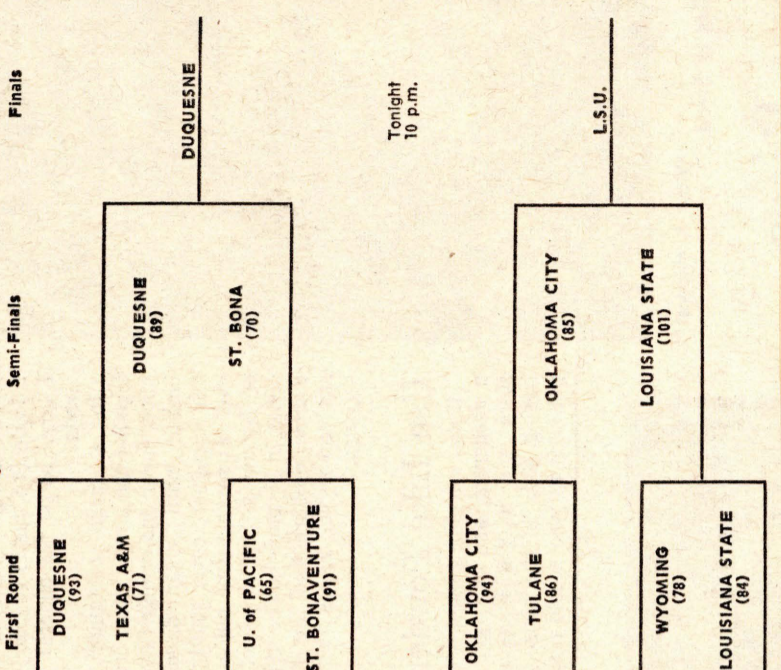

Bona In Tonight's Consolation

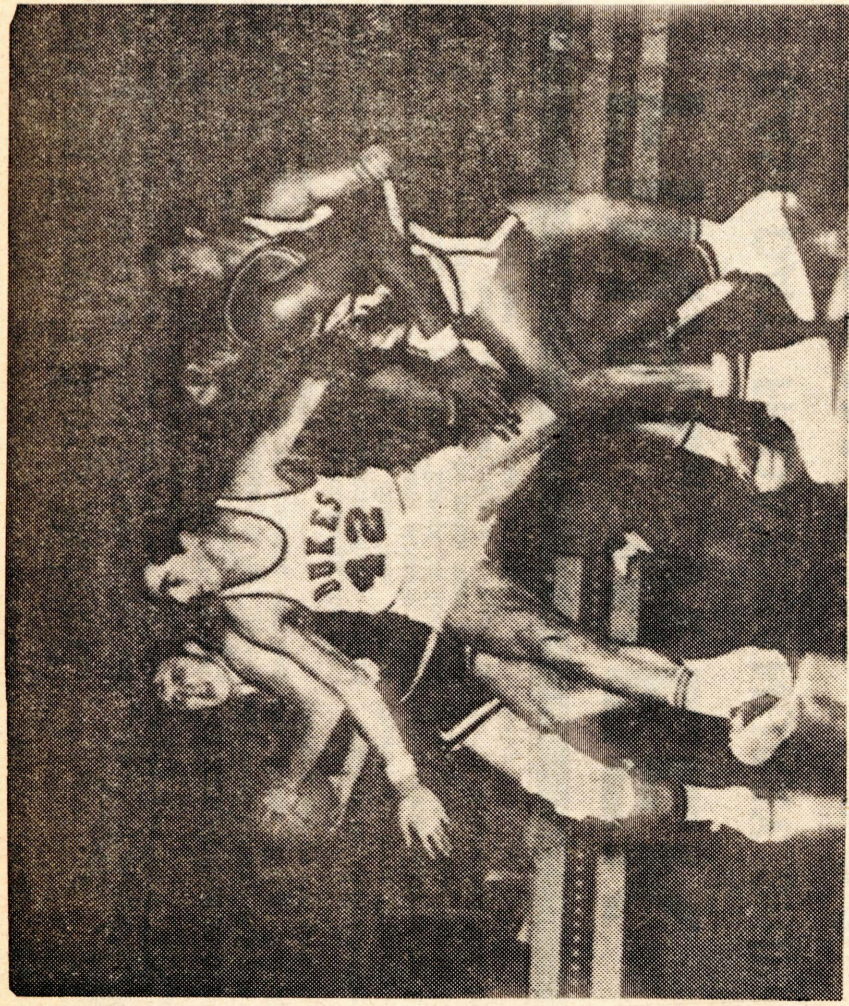
