in the 2^d & 3^d Regt. I have always found
this for money I guess I saved 300 home
and you can take it and keep it for me if James
ever get back if not you do what give to
the ones that need it most if there is any
sick we are going direct to Washington via
of Baltimore and the shortest where next
I do like to know why Mockham has not

is coming to Ellinikou and they consend

Washington or close there yestes day a mere
skirmish two or three killed I have not time
