Know Ye, That reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity and abilities of Augustus Wilson
I do hereby appoint him 1st Sergeant in Company K of the 58th Regiment of Penna Volunteers
Inftry in the service of the UNITED STATES, to rank as such from the third day of October, one thousand eight hundred and
Sixty One. He is therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the duty of 1st Sergeant by doing and performing all manner
of things thereunto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all Non Commissioned Officers and Soldiers under his command to
be obedient to his orders as 1st Sergeant. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time, as he
shall receive from me, or the future Commanding Officer of the Regiment, or other Superior Officers, and Non Commissioned Officers, set
over him, according to the rules and discipline of War. This Warrant to continue in force during the pleasure of the Commanding Of-
ficer of the Regiment for the time being.
