Know De, that Reposing special trust and confidence in the patriotism, valor, fidelity, and activities of <u>Augustus Wilson</u> I do hereby appoint him <u>1st Sergeant</u> in company <u>K</u> of the <u>58th</u> regiment of <u>Penna Volunteers Infty</u> in the service of the United states, to rank as such from the third day of October, one thousand eight hundred and and <u>Sixty One</u>. He is therefore carefully, and diligently to discharge the duty of <u>1st Sergeant</u> by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging. And I do strictly charge and require all Non Commissioned Officers and Soldiers under his command to be obedient to his orders as <u>1st Sergeant</u>. And he is to observe and follow such orders and directions from time to time, as he shall receive from me or the future Commanding Officer of the Regiment, or other Superior Officers and Non Commissioned Officers set over him according to the rules and discipline of War. This Warrant to continue enforce during the pleasure of the Commanding Officer of the Regiment for the time being.
