The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound Augustus Wilson shall discharge the duties of Justice of the Peace and for the Township of Muncy Creek in the said county of Lycoming, and make a faithful application of all moneys that shall come into his hands as an officer under his Commission of said office, then this obligation to be said, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue(?) in law
