July 1st 1862

Dear Father I thought
I woud write a few lines
to night to let you know
that I am well. I am getting
ready for a March early to
morrows Morning. we are
going to Warington a little
village about 8 miles from
here. There is no knowing
how long we shall stay there
we may stop there one
night & then go some
where else. we dont know
we have had a pretty good

time to day, we had a gun
& fired a few rounds of
Blank cartridges

I havent had a letter since
the 21 of June I expect one
to night. I sent a Box of
cloths yesterday there was
my Blanket & coat. Samt
sent 2 coats Fayt perman
sent a Blanket & some other
things & Mike Riley sent
one overcoat they are
all marked so you can
tell them. I sent it by
Express if you can
pay the cost I will
send it as soon as we
get our pay & that will
be in a few days now
writing soon & I will
write as soon as we
get so I can
