Dearest Mother

I can perform this little duty with the greatest pleasure. I am well and am always glad to hear that you all enjoy the same kind Blessing

We are to move again tomorrow or the day after. Beaufort is said to be our destination but whatever is for us to do I feel the lord will be our guide. Yesterday I heard 3 good sermons and enjoyed them very much and pray that what I heard may be blest to my spiritual good.

This morning is quite cool for this place and there is every prospect of a storm. I pray the Lord will prosper us 8 months 8 days more then I by his blessing will see your dear faces again. I shall be so glad

Savannah is getting dull to me. I hope they will place us in a more northern atmosphere before hot weather comes and where I shall get your letters as sure as they are wrote

Yours of Dec 25th was the last I have recieved. It was acceptable I assure you and I have longed for mails to bring some more of those welcome missives. Please pardon me if I dont fill up this sheet this time for news is so scarce give my sweetest love to all and I am yours truly and Aff.
