

Camp near Dalmouth Va Jan 2<sup>d</sup> 1868

Dear Wife and Boys

I guess it is the best thing I can do to spend a little time in writing to you as I have a few moments time to myself I am well at present and tough as a bear you know my Comman left was 165 lbs when at home but I now weight 185 and still gaining so you see I am doing pretty well in that respect at any rate we are here in the same place we were when last wrote to you and I know not but we shall stay here some time yet the prospect is fair for it at present we think we shall get our pay now in a few days at most but we cant tell untill we get it in our hand and hardly then but we hope for the best and that is all we can do but you shall have it as soon as possible for I suppose you need it very much and if I do not get it soon I will get you some in some other way if I can and I guess I can in some way & how Calista I want you to write as soon as you get this and let me know how you get along and if the Doctor has said or done any thing more about the house if he says any thing more about it tell him that you will write to me about it and do as I say be it what it may and then let me know what he says and I will write to him my self and see what effect that will have on him I guess I can stop him till the first of Apr if not I will oppose him in a publick manner at least and see what that will do

but I must close for want of time  
now write as soon as you get this for I  
have not heard from you in a long time  
and am getting quite uneasy about it  
so good by for this time
