

Ellington City Cemetery:
W. S. Bacon 1842-1927 Plat 13
Sarah Ann Bacon Oct 5, 1846-July 29, 1917 Plat 16

Ellington Press: July 7, 1927 issue: Died July 2,1927 Died; W. S. Bacon age 8X 83, resident 12 or 15 years, he was a civil War veteran.

Ellington Press: July 10, 1919 issue, page 1, collum 1: Ill: Mrs. W. S. Bacon; confined to bed for past 4 weeks.

Ellington Press: July 31, 1919 issue, page 1 collum 1: Died: Mrs. W. S. Bacon; ill for the past 6 weeks; at komme her home here; last Tuesday evening.

Page 4, Collum 2:

Obit: Sarah A. (Hicks) Bacon; wife of W. S. Bacon, born Oct 5, 1846 at Ashford, Chatterugas Co., NY, Died 6:25 PM Tuesday, July 29, 1919 after a serious illness of 6 weeks, age 72 years 10 mos 24 days. Married W. S. Bacon in East Otto, New York, in 1868. Eight children, four preceded her in death. Survived by her husband two sisters, four children, 25 grandchildren, 2 great grandchildren. Funeral by Rev. Bates at the Methodist Church; burial in the Ellington Cemetery.

Although William's obit says he was a resident for 12 or 15 years I was unable to locate him on 1920 or 1910 Reynolds Co. censuses.
