Alexandria Va Sept 1st/63

Dear Ann and Children

again I seat myself to talk with you I received yours last evening on my return from the 2nd Corps 1st Division and 2nd Brigade they are near Kelley's ford on the Rapahanock I had been out there in command of drafted men we are here on that kind of duty now guarding them to their Regiments we go on the cars to the nearest Station with a guard detailed from our Brigade and after delivering them return on the cars it takes about two days for a trip I have been twice since we came here last tuesday and like it well I went on Sunday and that night staid in the 64th with Capt Hunt and Capt Wait and Chaplain Hibbard but slept in the Chaplains tent. we had a good visit, they sent their respects to you when I got back vesterday found Wm Henry here and I tell you I was glad to see him he is fat as a pig and feels well. to day I have been up to the paroll camp with Lieut Chapman who also came yesterday and have seen most of the parolled prisoners of our Regt had a real good visit it seemed like meeting friends at home after being so long away from them as we had stood side by side on the field where death was dealing destruction broadcast around and I had to describe the seenes of Gettysburg for them. I am still in the Regt and if we stay here where there is not much marching to do I mean to stay in it but am satisfied that I cannot stand it to march as we have done nor shall I try it. we expect to be paid next week or at farthest week after and then I shall send you the money by Express. tell John he can sell the team for what they will fetch but I want the pay turned in on my debts for I am anxious to get out of debt as soon as I can. you asked me if you should knit me a pair of mitten I think not but knit me one or two pair of socks and I will write when I want them. as to the cheese making that you and Joe talked of you can count me in on that contract for if we have good luck and I get home safe and sound I intend to go there within six months after I come home for I am getting old fast and I do not calculate to work land on shares any more after I get out of the service now Dear I believe I have answered all of your questions as well as I could and I shall draw to a close. I just got the mail and got a letter from Libbie and little Joe with a little pin cussion from the Girls. tell Flore and Allie to write for I feel as though they are forgetting me when they do not write and now good night all and may God protect and care for us untill we meet is the prayr of your Aff
