Co. B. 154th. Regt., N.Y. Volunteers, for three years  
Enrolled at Mansfield and mustered in 24 Sep. 1862 at  
Jamestown, N.Y. Taken prisoner at Gettysburg 1 July 1863  
and died at U.S. General Hospital, Annapolis, Maryland  
24 Aug. 1863. Paroled at City Point, Va. 2 Aug. 1863  
and at Camp Parole, Maryland 3 Aug. 1863.

Affidavit:- 21 July 1873 Ruth Calkins ae 47 yrs. of  
Cattaraugus Co., N.Y. swears she is the wife of Darick  
Calkins and the mother of James Calkins who enlisted at  
Mansfield, Cattaraugus Co., N.Y. That James never  
married so there is no widow or children. He was 20 on  
the 25 Nov. 1862. Her husband, Darick Calkins, ae. 55 yrs  
is physically unable to support her or the remaining

mustered in 24 Sep. 1862 Jamestown, N.Y. Taken prisoner  
at Gettysburg 1 July 1863 and died at U.S. General Hospital  
Annapolis, Maryland 24 Aug. 1863. Paroled ay City Point  
Va. 2 Aug. 1863 and at Camp Barole, Md. 3 Aug 1863.

Affidavit :- 21 July 1873 Ruth Calkins, ae. 47 of Cattaraugus Co., N.Y. swears she is the wife of Darick Calkins and mother of James Calkins who enlisted at Mansfield, Cattaraugus Co., N.Y. That James never married so there is no widow or children; He was 20 on 25 Nov. 1862. Her husband, Darick Calkins ae 55 yrs. is physically unable to support her or the remaining children; these are, besides James, Roxy, b. 8 Feb. 1851
