Dear Relative,

Your letter was
handed me by our post
mistress. I am glad
someone is getting a
history of the Campbells.

I am a daughter of
Harrison Campbell and
have lived in the vicinity
of the Allen Campbell home
most of my life. I believe
your information correct
so far as given. However
there were three children
of Allen Campbell not

mentioned² Mary, Josephine
and Warren, all deceased.

Will give information if
you wish.

According to Co. H. E. History,
Allen Campbell settled
here in 1835, was justice
of the Peace most all his
life. For many years
he was a lumber mfg.
and prominent in
public affairs.

My father, Harrison C.
was born Aug 30, 1837
He was married to Mary
J. Flagg who died May 27,
1882, at birth of their son,
Harry M Campbell.

On July 25, 1862 my father
enrolled in Co A-157 Reg.
New York Vol. He served
three years, for a time

was prisoner at Bell Isle
and was in following
engagements

Chancellorsville, Va ^{May 3,} 1863
Lookout Valley, Tenn. Oct 28, 1863
Lookout Mountain .. Nov 23, 1863
Rocky Face, Ga. May 8, 1864

These last facts are
copied from his discharge
given May 13, 1865.

After returning home Sept
7, 1876 he was married to
Mathie L Flagg, sister of
former wife. So this
union were born
Maud Campbell Wiltzie (deceased)
Carmilla .. Gates
Ruth E .. (deceased)
Howe Allen Campbell of
Salamanca, A. G.

My father bought a small farm 2 or 3 miles from old homestead, here our child hood was spent. He was very public spirited was com. of Indian schools for a number of years.

His death occurred Dec 6. 1901.

At present, you will notice there are 3 of H. C.'s children living, eldest son,

Harry M Campbell, was in Spanish Am. war and has position at Allegheny State Park where he resides with his family. Youngest son,

Howe A. Campbell, was served about 2 yrs in world war, in France, Res. Salamanca, N.Y.

Have been told there is a history of Campbell

family in Uncle Warren Campbell's family. If I get any information worth while, I will let you know.
