"A man named Cone, a member of the 154th N.Y. volunteers, was reported killed at Chancellorsville, his funeral sermon was preached at Salamanca in Cattaraugus county, and his wife made application for his bounty and back pay. Luckily, however, she was in no hurry to marry again, for a few weeks ago her husband came all right, having only been wounded and a prisoner in rebel hands."
