## JAMES DALLAS 1836 - 1917 Company B, 154th N.Y. Vols.

James Dallas was the son of Scottish parents who emigrated to Sugar Grove, Warren County, Pennsylvania, in 1834. His father, John Dallas, was born May 2, 1802, and died October 4, 1881. His mother, Jennet Henry Dallas, died June 8, 1838, aged 37 years. Both are buried in Cherry Hill Cemetery, Sugar Grove. John's second wife, Mary, died June 10, 1863, aged 43 years, and is buried in the same cemetery.

James Dallas was born in Sugar Grove in 1836. He was married to Julia A. Parkman, daughter of Benjamin Parkman of Perrysburg, New York, on Wednesday, August 29, 1860. Three of their children died in infancy. A son, John B. Dallas, was born December 17, 1876 in Sugar Grove. He committed suicide by hanging, May 26, 1932, in Sugar Grove.

Their headstones in Cherry Hill Cemetery read, "James Dallas 1836-1917" and "Julia A. Dallas 1841-1903."
