Dr. Reuben Eggleston enlisted 25 Jul 1862 from Allegany, New York, as a private in Co. C, 154th New York Volunteers. He was a surgeon and member of the ambulance corps, 2d Brigade, 2d Division, 20th Corps; date of his death came from a letter of Lt. Warren Oman, Chief of the Ambulance Corps, to the widow 1 Oct 1864, Rev. Charles C. Eggleston of Franklinville, NY, preached the funeral sermon for Mrs. Phidelia E. Barnes in 1903. Reuben R. Eggleston is in the census at Ellicott, Chautaugua Co., NY, 1840 (1 male 20-30, 1 female, 15-20); 1850, Burton, Cattaraugus Co., (as R. Eggleston, 39, physician; Fidelia, 28; Samuel T. Culver, 33, all b. NY); 1860 Allegany, same co. (Reuben R. and wife).

DEATH: Died Division Hosp, Atlanta, Georgia.

Reuben married **Phidelia LEROY** on 13 Feb 1839. Phidelia was born 30 Apr 1821 in Massachusetts. She died 1903 in Albany, New York.
