THE 154TH.--This Regiment contained two companies from Chautauqua, (Co. E, Capt. J. B. Fay, of Portland, and Co. F, Capt. Thos. Donnelly, of Sinclearville,) and has been very unfortunate. Its service has been mostly rendered in Virginia, but it is now in Georgia under Gen. SHERMAN. A part of it was captured at the Battle of Gettysburg, but afterward exchanged. We learn that two months ago, it numbered only one hundred and eight muskets, and that Co. F was for a number of months under the command of one of the sergeants. We suppose Co. E is now under command of Capt. Fay, who sometime since having been exchanged out of "the Libby," left home to rejoin his regiment.
