Also on account of Deafness in both ears left ear nearly worthless

incurred at Camp about 4 miles up Savannah River

from Savannah City just before the capture of Savannah Ga. by the bursting of a 100 # shell from

foot That none of said disabilities are due to vicious habits, and that they are to the best of his knowledge and

belief of a permanent character,
