JOEL M. BOUTON--Age 23 years. Enlisted July 29, 1862 at Olean, to serve three years; mustered in as corporal, Co. C, September 24, 1862; killed in action July 1, 1863 at Gettysburg, Pa.

CHAMPLIN, MARTIN V. B.--Age 21 years. Enlisted August 9, 1862 at Portville, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, September 24, 1862; killed in action May 2, 1863 at Chancellorsville, Va.

KEYES, AMOS F.--Age 35 years. Enlisted August 9, 1862 at Portville, to serve three years; mustered in as corporal, Co. C, September 24, 1862; died December 29, 1862 at Falmouth, Va.

LAMB, HARRIS--Age 23 years. Enlisted July 26, 1862 at Portville, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, September 24, 1862; captured in action July 1, 1863 at Gettysburg, Pa.; paroled, no date; transferred to Veteran Reserve Corps January 15, 1864.

SIKES, SEYMOUR--Age 25 years. Enlisted August 9, 1862 at Portville, to serve three years; mustered in as private, Co. C, September 24, 1862; promoted corporal prior to April 10, 1863; killed in action May 2, 1863 at Chancellorsville, Va.

VAN AERNAM, HENRY--Age 45 years. Enrolled at Jamestown, to serve three years, and mustered in as surgeon August 20, 1862; discharged November 5, 1864.

WARNER, LEWIS D.--Age 40 years. Enrolled August 19, 1862 at Jamestown, to serve three years; mustered in as captain, Co. C, September 26, 1862; as major, June 30, 1863; as lieutenant colonel, January 19, 1865; promoted colonel, March 24, 1865; mustered out with regiment June 11, 1865 near Bladensburg, Md.
