Taylor, all formerly members of our company, and taken prisoners at Gettysburg, Pa. July 1, 1863, have since died of wounds contracted in Rebel hands, and while still remaining unexchanged, therefore

Resolved, That with deep sorrow, we have from time to time received the sad announcements of the deaths of our beloved and faithful companions in arms.

Resolved, That in the departure of these, our dearly-esteemed associates, we have lost brave and truly noble men.

Resolved, That we sincerely sympathize with the families, friends and relatives of the deceased, and pray that they may be comforted by the Great Comforter of All.
