I have known Lieut Bundy since the transfer of the 11th & 12th Corps to this Department in October last and it has been my fortune to serve in the same Division with him during the present campaign when opportunities have been almost daily presented to see and judge the metal of which soldiers are composed

It affords me the greatest pleasure to join in the general recommendation and desire for the promotion of Lieut Bundy as a New York soldier I feel great pride in his bravery and skill as an officer, and hazard nothing when I say that he has no superior of his rank in the army and is well entitled to all the confidence and trust which his Excellency the Governor may see fit to repose in him
