

Head Quartermaster 154th Regt N. Y. Vol
Look Out Valley Team.
January 27th 1864

General

I have the honor to request that a leave
of absence be granted me for thirty five (35) days
for the purpose of returning to Cattaraugus County
in the State of New York - the County in which
my Regiment was raised. For the following
reasons

I am assured by the War Committee of
the Citizens of the County that I can procure
by personal efforts of my own, a sufficient number
of men to recruit my Regiment, which is now reduct-
ed below the minimum - Four hundred and ninety
two (492) men Two hundred & eight (288) within
the department.

Efforts have hitherto been made to
recruit this Regiment, but the men procured
of its Officers have been diverted to other organiza-
tions, and the Officers themselves retained in the
State upon the General Recruiting Service. Large
Counties for volunteers are now being offered by the
