

WINFIELD S. KENYON SUCCUMBS TO ILLNESS

FORMER RANDOLPH RESIDENT DIED AT SALAMANCA

SURVIVOR OF THE 154TH VOLS.

Died Yesterday Morning at his Home on Front Ave., Salamanca--The Funeral will be Held Tomorrow with Burial at Randolph.

Winfield S. Kenyon died yesterday morning at 5:15 o'clock at his home at 29 Front avenue, Salamanca, following an illness of some duration.

He was born in New Albion in 18?? and had been a life long resident of Cattaraugus county. For many years he lived in Randolph and for the past 1? years had been a resident of Salamanca. He was a veteran of the Civil war, serving in Co. B, 154th-Reg., and was a member of Sherwood Post, G.A.R.

He is survived by four daughters, Mrs. J. Lynn Blessing of 43 Front avenue, Salamanca, and Misses Mona, Bertha and Doris Kenyon, living at his home, two sisters, Mrs. R.H. Butterfield of Little Valley and Mrs. Mary Wilson of Findlay, O.; one brother, H.B. Kenyon of Little Valley.

The funeral services will be held from the home Saturday morning at 10 o'clock; Rev. D. Howard Dow of St. Mary's church will officiate. The G.A.R. will attend in a body and act as escort to the train, the funeral party leaving over the Erie at 12:15 for Randolph, where interment will take place in Randolph cemetery.
