Prof. Samuel G. Love, for many years Superintendent of the Jamestown public schools, died at his home in that city on Sunday morning last, in the 70th year of his age.

Prof. Love was born in Orleans Co., N. Y., graduated at Hamilton College and taught in the Buffalo public schools for several years. From Buffalo he went to Randolph to be the first principal of Chamberlain Institute and a few years later to be the first superintendent of the Jamestown public schools, which position he held for 25 years when he resigned to accept the position of librarian of the Prendergast free library. He is well remembered as a man of great will power by all the older educators of this county.
