Gany River Improvement—No. 1.

Independence of the Castarragus Freeman.
ALLRAGNY, FEBRUARY 6, 1867.
I wish briefly to state to the numerous readers of the Freeman some facts connected with the much needed improvement of the Allegheny river, by means which can be applied with comparatively small expense, and which will be a cheap, safe and expeditious slack communication from Olean to the contiguous depot at the junction of the Atlantic & Western with the Erie Railway. This important subject has been in contemplation several years; and at the last session of the Legislature, an appropriation was made providing for a thorough survey of the river between the points indicated, with a view of ascertaining the feasibility of the contemplated improvement. A competent and experienced engineer has been employed by the State, made the survey during the past season, and the result of a report at least as favorable to the most ardent friends of the work could have been had, had the precise figures of the river at hand, and unable to give the width in the river, from Olean to the point mentioned, a distance of about 18 miles, in but a few days. To make this portion of the river navigable for boats and construct a suitable tow-path upon its bank, requires an appropriation of a comparatively insignificant when we take in consideration the vast interests that will accrue by the completion of this important enterprise. The benefits of this improvement could not be confined to the towns along the river, but by its important connections with all roads and the Genesee Valley Canal and extension, incalculable benefits would be conferred upon a large portion of the Western part of the State. Petitions asking for its appropriation are being sent to the Legislature, and the Legislature will give the measure their cordial support, and urge the justness of the claims upon the members of both Houses. It is a project that challenges every patriotic citizen's attention. For more information, apply to the undersigned.

HEAD-QUARTERS 154th REG'T N. Y. V.,
LOCKPORT VALLEY, TENN., Jan. 7, '67.

At a meeting of the officers of the 154th Reg't N. Y. Vols., called upon the occasion of the withdrawal from the service of Reverend Henry D. Lowing, Chaplain of the Regiment, Col. P. H. Jones was called to the Chair, and Lieut. A. W. Benson chosen Secretary. On motion a committee of three, consisting of Maj. J. D. Warner, Capt. A. Hotchkiss, and Lieut. W. S. Cameron, was appointed to submit resolutions expressive of the sense of the meeting. The committee offered the following, which were unanimously adopted:

Whereas, the Rev. Henry D.
