dear rhoda i recieved a letter from you last tuesday at Centerville and a paper from elisabeth you no doubt know that we air again on the march we air again on the march we started friday went to hartwood church saturday we went to cattles station sunday we went along the rail road to minnasas Junction and then to bull run and stayed all nite on the banks of the creek monday we went to Centerville about 9 miles and stayed till wensday morning when we started and got here in the afternoon making a march of about 80 miles i do not know how long we will stay over we shall go next we air about 15 miles from harpers fery near peasfery and earwards fery i hope you will write often tell me all about that new church what kind of a building it is to be if they cant build it without the help of soldiers the had better quit i hope the menister will fair better then they have don
