Baltimore Md Sept 9 1863

Dear Rhoda I have not got to my redgement yet and I dont know when I will there on munday I leaf getysburg on the 1 oclock train with 19 union and 15 reble soldiers and got to Baltimore at sunset and went to the provo marshel he shut up the rebles and sent us to the union relief to super we got ham bread and coffey teusday we took breakfas and dinner in there and in the after noon he sent us to this camp to be sent to our redgements some time no body knows when I found one man from my company here that was taken sick 4 month ago and went to washington from the redgement saying that they ware at Alexandra guarding conscrips i am afraid that it will be along time before i will get my pay now if i stay here 2 month i may get it and if i get to the redgement i will get it when the pay master comes again i think that the y have just been payed but i am safe to get it some time

I would like to know how much money you have got yet I am afraid you will be out before i can send you any write soon and let me know how you are getting along write an soon as posable
