As I have a few leisure moments to spend in writing I will that I will write you a few lines to inform you that I am well and hope this will find you the same I left home the 6th of September bore the army I went to Atlanta I staid there till the fifteenth of November then we started for Savannah where we are yet but we shall march here tomorrow morning bore Chattanooga Tennessee or Richmond we don't know which we was one month on the road when we came to Savannah now long we shall be on the road this march we don't know but the think that we shall be about thirty days on the road if we have as good a time on this
