Dear Sister

As I have a fiew Lasure moments to Spend in writing I thot that I wold Write you a fiew Lines to Inform you that I am well and hope this will find you the Same I Left home the Six of September fore the army I went to Atalanta I tade thare till the fifteenth of November then we Started fore Sayannah whare we are yet but we Shall march from here tomorrow morning fore Charleston South Carolina or Richmon We Dont Know which. we was one month on the Rode when we Came to Savannah how Long we Shall be on the rode this march we Dont Know but We think we shall be a bout thirty Days on the rode if we have as good a time on this As we Did on the other I Shall be Satisfide pirty well we had plenty to Eat the forageing was first Rate Sweet potatoes and Chickins and fresh pork. Martin bowin is With mie and and so is James husbon George pettit and Marggeris brother So you See that I aint A Lone Yet I want you to rite What Alford's Address is so I Can Wright to him wright what regament he belngs to and whare he is and What Company. Net I understand that brother is mairied agane if that is So write and tell mie write all about the folks. tell D _____'s wife that her brother Is here with mie and he is well And harty tell her to write to Mee and i will answer it as Soon as i get it. tell D _____ that I hope that he wont hef to Come to war fare it is A hard life to live but I Woldent Sae So to Everyone but you wont tell what I Say to you to Discourage men from Coming to help put Down the rebellion but I dont want Enny more of my friends in it. tell Joel that he had better pay all that he has got be fore he Comes. I wold give All that I have got be fore I wold Come agane it is the hardist plase that I Ever Was in. but thank God I havent But Seven months to Stay from the Six of next Septtenber then if the Lord is wilng I Shall go home again to See my famaly Again Yet you must go and see my folks and Keep them in good Cheer So good by fore this time from your brother A. D. Reed
