**MEMBERS OF THE 154th NEW YORK
WHO ENLISTED AT CANANDAIGUA
IN MARCH, 1865**

WILLIAM BISHOP--Age 20 years. Enlisted at Canandaigua, to serve one year, and mustered in as private, Co. K, March 1, 1865; transferred to 102nd Infantry June 9, 1865 while absent without leave.

PETER B. PYATT--Age 20 years. Enlisted at Canandaigua, to serve one year, and mustered in as private, unassigned, March 1, 1865; mustered out May 15, 1865 at Hart's Island, New York Harbor.

NORMAN ROSE--Age 23 years. Enlisted at Canandaigua, to serve one year, and mustered in as private, Co. K, March 1, 1865; transferred to 102nd Infantry June 9, 1865.

MARTIN V. B. SNYDER--Age 19 years. Enlisted at Canandaigua, to serve one year, and mustered in as private, Co. K, March 1, 1865; transferred to 102nd Infantry June 9, 1865.

JOHN SPERLING--Age 18 years. Enlisted at Canandaigua, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Co. K, March 28, 1865; transferred to 102nd Infantry June 9, 1865.

RICHARD C. WOOD--Age 26 years. Enlisted at Canandaigua, to serve three years, and mustered in as private, Co. K, March 1, 1865; transferred to 102nd Infantry June 9, 1865.
