Know Ye, That *Francis Strickland* an *Order Sergeant* of *Captain* *Company*, *154th* *Regiment of New York Volunteers* who was enrolled on the *third* day of *September* one thousand eight hundred and *Sixty Two* is hereby Discharged from the service of the United States, this *1st* day of *October*, 1863, at *Harrisburg Pa.* by reason of the loss of his right arm from a wound received in battle. He is physically suitable for service in the *disabled Corps* but prefers to be discharged.

Francis Strickland was born in *Sherburne*, in the State of *Yorkshire, England* is *thirty Two* years of age, five feet *9 3/4* inches high, *light* complexion, *blue* eyes, *brown* hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a *farmer*.

Given at *U.S. Genl. Hospital, Mulberry St. Harrisburg Pa.* this *1st* day of *October* 1863.
