Another week hath pased and since 1 wrote to you and 1 have not had a letter from you yet i did not expect any this week but i shall be very much disapointed if i do not get any this week it is now two month since 1 heard from you and 1 have written you a great many letters in that time When i got to the redgement i found that the priseneers that wer taken at Chanslervill was exchanged and dot back to John Wilson who was reported in the papers to be dad is here his wound is heled but he is not well and i dont think that he ever will be the same man again he had one brother kiled at Williansbirg and another died at Sufulk last winter dut i hope that he may get home alive we have been to work this week building rail road to suply the army at Chatanuga it seems like ole times to be with the Redgement again but we mis our offisers very much espeshaly the Captan but we hope they will soon be back with us i sopose you think hard that i am not at home be fore now well i did not expect to stay so long but now 1 am here and mus stay and 1f 1 was at home the chance is that i would have to come yet and perhaps leave you worst off tell you air now ind now i am here and my chance is better for 2 years more then a new man for I year but i dont think that i shall have to stay another year i trust that the Lord will give sucksses to our armey and that peace will again bless our land and we may enjoy our homes again i often think that if i will get home that i will know how to enjoy it after living so long more like a animel thon like a man but the son is down and i mus stop good nite and god bles you is my prayr
