this is a bright sumrey morning such as you may er see at this time of year but air very common here last satureday I went ut on racoon ridge and could see Chatanuga Misenary ridge and a grate extent of country and the distant Mountan look like black clouds rising in the sky sunday we had servise in camp 10 oclock held by the Christian Commission at 1 1/2 oclock there was service at the Chapal tent at the rail road and at 3 oclock a negrow preached for the benifet of the negroes Rhoda I am glad you like your ring so well them spots air sealing wax I was sory that I put them in as I thaught it looked better with out them that song was printed and sold in Chatanooga and as I did not get the chance to bui one I wrout it of it is song in 'a tune they call neley bly prehaps you dont know it but I must close as I want to write Maryann a few lines my love to you good wife
