I am sory that you have had the measels but hope that you may soon eet well and have good helth I hope that the fhildren will not be very sick and you must bee cairfull not to expose your iself and talre coal I an afraid thau you will be shori on for money be fore we eill be paied akain but I hope that you will mot have to suffer for any thing that you may need I hope that the lord will provide for all your wants and he will rase up iriends for you if you may necd them I am not afraid that you cannot live on what I can send you but it may bee several month before I can Eet my pay I under stand that we get 16 dollere per month from the first of Fuy hat dont binow sirten whither it ic 1000 a not
Rhoda I have been writeing while the redt of the boys have heen Eetting new potoes they air very small about the sise of hickery nuts in a fev weeaks they will be laree and blackberies will soon be ripe peaches air quite laree surawberies and rasberies do not erow here give iny love to all my frinds and may E゙Ods blessing be with you yours
