





PROGRAM A

Time: Approx. 45 minutes to 1 hour.

Group Size: unlimited

Venue: Where your group meets

I. An explanation of uniform and equipment including a U. S. Springfield rifled musket.

II. A sample of civil war band music.

III. An introduction to James Daniel Quilliam, a Union soldier from Chautauqua county and his letters to his wife.

IV. An introduction to John and Jefferson Baylis, 16 year old soldiers from Niagara county.

PROGRAM B

Time: Approx. 2 hours

Group Size: unlimited but 10-12 active participants

Venue: as provided by your group where open fire is allowed (such as private property in a rural area)

I. All of Program "A" and for the active participants experience hard fact and salt pork.

II. Eat a camp stew cooked in an iron pot with home cooked bread (for the active participants)

PROGRAM C

Time: Approx. 3 hours

Group Size: unlimited (includes 10-12 active participants)

Venue: group to provide area where open fire is allowed and it is legal to discharge firearms.

I. All of Program "A" and "B" plus active participants will actually fire the Springfield rifle and will experience the taste, smell, sights, feel and sound of black powder
