Description

Here's an old envelope, which also has a letter with it. The envelope has a postmark for FRANKLINVILLE N.Y. NOV 23.

It's addressed to John Manley, Esq., Washington D.C.

The enclosure consists of a one page letter written by H. Van Aernam.

The headline is Franklinville, Nov. 22d 1864.

From his Congressional biography: "VAN AERNAM, Henry, a Representative from New York; born in Marcellus, Onondaga County, N.Y., March 11, 1819; pursued an academic course; studied medicine at the Geneva and Willoughby Medical Colleges and practiced his profession; member of the State assembly in 1858; served in the Union Army as a surgeon in the One Hundred and Fifty-fourth Regiment, New York Volunteer Infantry, from September 26, 1862, to November 5, 1864; elected as a Republican to the Thirty-ninth and Fortieth Congresses (March 4, 1865-March 3, 1869); appointed as Commissioner of Pensions May 1, 1869, and served until May 31, 1871, when he resigned; elected to the Forty-sixth and Forty-seventh Congresses (March 4, 1879-March 3, 1883); resumed the practice of medicine in Franklinville, Cattaraugus County, N.Y., and died there June 1, 1894; interment in Mount Prospect Cemetery."

"Inclosed please find Paymaster's Draft on New York for \$103.35, the avail'y of the assignment of one month's pay of Lt Chas. W. Church 154th N.Y.S. Vols."

"I regret the tardiness ..."

"The Regiment is now on the way to Savannah or some other point on the ocean or Gulf with Genl Sherman. I left Atlanta Ga, on the 6th inst. The 'boys' were then all well, and in fine spirits. Col. Jones wished to be remembered to you ..."

"I hope to see you sometime during the winter if my health is sufficient for the trip to Washington."

Condition of the letter rates good. I hope the scan gives you a general idea of the condition.


