The Regiment is now on the way to Savannah  
or some other point on the Ocean or Gulf with  
Genl Sherman. I left Atlanta Ga on the 6<sup>th</sup> inst.

The "boys" were then all well, and in fine spirits.  
— Col Jones wished to be remembered to you particularly.  
His health was much improved.

I hope to see you sometime during the winter if my  
health is sufficient for the trip to Washington. Let me hear  
from you.
