Company, (6th) Sixth Regiment of Militia Reserve Corps
VOLUNTEERS, who was enrolled on the Thirtieth day of August
 one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five to serve Three (3) years or
 during the war, is hereby **Discharged** from the service of the United States
 this Fifth (5th) day of July, 1865, at Cincinnati
Ohio by reason of General Order No. 16, War Dept. U.S.A. dated June 17th 1865.
 (No objection to his being re-enlisted is known to exist.)

Said William F. Vinton was born in Ellicottville
 in the State of New York, is Seventy-four years of age,
Six feet inches high, Light complexion, Blue eyes,
Dark hair, and by occupation, when enrolled, a Musician
 Given at Cincinnati, Ohio this Fifth (5th) day of
July, 1865.
