Sept 27th 1862

dear mother

i thought i would rite to you to let you know that i am well and hope this will find you the same. We are going to leave monday i expect they are getting our rations redy now i shall send this by nancy i shall send you thirty dollars now and the next will be a check so you can get the money at any bank or they will give you trade at any store you like if the check is lost it is good for nothing to the one that gets it and you will get another in the plase of the one lost dont rite till you here from me again good by for this time
