DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890, and Act of May 9, 1900, <sup>April 19, 1908</sup>

State of New York, County of Cattaraugus ss:

ON THIS 22<sup>d</sup> day of March, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and fifteen personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the county and state aforesaid Mary D. Park aged 69 years, whose Post Office address is Dayton R.F.D. No. 7, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of Andrew G. Park who enlisted under the name of Andrew G. Park, at Leon Pa. on the 10 day of Aug, A. D., 1862 in Co. B. 154 R. N.Y. Inf. (Here state rank, company, and regiment, if in Army—unit, if in Navy.)

and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, and was honorably discharged June 17 1865 and died Mar 17 1915

That she was married under the name of Mary D. Hall to said Andrew G. Park on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January 1866 by E. H. Tingley at Lawrence Pa. there being no legal barrier to said marriage.

That she has not remarried since the death of the said Andrew G. Park

That she is without other means of support than her daily labor, and an actual net income not exceeding \$250 per year; that names and dates of birth of all the children now living under sixteen years of age of the soldier are as follows:

That her husband has not been employed in the Military or Naval service or otherwise than as stated above

That she has not heretofore applied for pension and the number of her former application is Soldiers Cert #805863 (Be careful to fill in the blank correctly.)

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890, and Act of May 9, 1900

She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Millard McAlister of Lawanda County of Cattaraugus Mary D. Park her true and lawful attorney to prosecute her claim, and to receive therefor
