## Limited Admission

Admission to St. Bonaventure is limited to those applicants who satisfy the University's Committee on Admissions regarding their academic achievement, personality and character. They must present a diploma from an approved secondary school with a minimum of 16 units, including 10 in the academic area and a sequence. Other requirements include satisfactory scores on the College Examination Boards Scholastic Aptitude Test, evidence of academic attainment and potential and a certification of good health. Details of the Admission process appear in the University's Bulletin.

To be admitted to the Department of Journalism, the student should have a high academic standing. Students who have completed the Freshman Arts program and a one-credit course in publication work are admitted as majors in Journalism in their Sophomore year after an interview and upon presentation of evidence of professional interest in communications.
