




Setting

The staff is divided by categories of poetry, prose, artwork, and photography. The Laurel staff is responsible for actually piecing the magazine together.



The staff is excited about the Spring 1998 edition which will be the first time ever for them to have artwork done in color.


That's not the only overwhelming excitement in the Laurel's office. They are all looking forward to next year's 100th anniversary edition. They have a lot of planning to get done.
















Bonadieu
