

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
*SCENES*

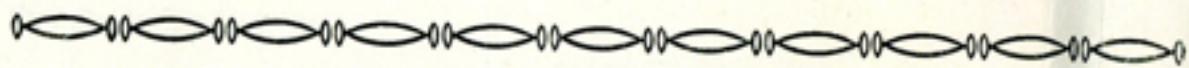
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ACT I—Cappy Rick's Office, California Street, San Francisco. Morning.
